Well, I'd rather say this website is nothing near a secret. It has been used by few Nigerians who deal in computer importing business. The name of this website is Ali Express and can be located at: www.AliExpress.com

AliExpress.com is a part of the popular import and export online shop known as AliBaba (www.alibaba.com). They have been in the business for the past 13 years and they are known to be the world's number 1 online shop for computer and accessories and other related goods. Most China manufacturers have their goods showcased on these websites.

As an individual buyer, what you need is AliExpress, while Alibaba is for wholesalers. This is the exact website many computer stores at Computer Village, Ikeja buy their laptops and sell for higher price.

Although, AliExpress do not only sell computer, they also sell computer accessories and other products such as:

- Mobile Phones
- Computers & Networking
- Electronics
- Apparels
- Auto Parts & Electronic
- Wedding Supplies
- Home & Garden

- Shoes & Accessories
- Sports & Entertainment
- Bags, Cases & Luggage
- Jewelry & Watches
- Health & Beauty
- Toys & Hobbies
- And much more...

Since our aim is to purchase a laptop computer, we are going to focus on this solemnly. If you want to purchase any other product, simply follow the same procedure. I have once purchased a Bluetooth Keyboard and Mouse from **AliExpress** using the same procedure I'm going to outline here in this report.

Type of Laptops to Expect

There are different brands of laptops sold on AliExpress but we will focus on what is called **OEM** – Original Equipment Manufacturer. This means that the Merchants are also the Manufacturers of the laptops, and are not only cheap but are of good quality. There are also other brands such as HP, Acer, Dell, etc but these brands are costlier than the OEMs.

These OEM brands are very good and quality laptops. There are different big companies and organizations that use the service of these OEM to get quality and cheap products. You can also confirm how good and quality a product is by checking through the comment/feedback section of each product.

The interesting part is this... you can brand the goods just with a little extra fee. What this means is that merchant can brand your name or your company's name on the laptops been sold to you. This will portray you as the manufacturer of that laptop. This is good especially to companies that wanted to start selling their own custom-made brand of laptops and accessories or for individuals who just wanted the 'effizy' of seeing his name as the manufacturer of his laptop.

At **AliExpress**, you can get very quality products at very cheap prices. You can even negotiate prices if you want to buy in bulk because the more you buy, the lesser you pay. Any product you are buying on AliExpress, you are saving almost half the price compare to the price in Nigeria market. This is what I mean... a 320GB 10 inches laptop with 2GB RAM, Bluetooth, WiFi, 3G, Webcam, Dual Core, etc, is been sold at the price of about N160,000 - N180,000 in Nigeria, but you can get this same laptop at the rate of about N52,000 on AliExpress. You get it now?

How to Order for Your Brand New Laptop from AliExpress

This is what we've been waiting for, right? But before I go into the nitty gritty of the whole process, I will like to point out some important issue that might be bordering your mind.

I know by now you might be thinking... is my money safe in the hands of these guys?

Well, all I can say is YES.

Reason?

There are many reasons I trusted **AliExpress** and its merchants, I will list few below:

• I have purchased and received my laptop right here in Ilorin, Kwara State, Nigeria without any hassle.

- Most merchant on AliExpress are verified sellers. They won't want to jeopardize their future opportunity just because of the little money they want to collect from you.
- They are a child company of the number 1 General Merchant online store called alibaba.com
- You are protected by VeriSign; an encryption service that helps protect your Credit Card online transaction
- And lastly, AliExpress uses **Escrow**. With Escrow, your money is safe. If you purchased any product from AliExpress, you don't have to pay the merchant directly. You will send the money to Escrow first, and then when you get the product you paid for, you can then ask Escrow to release the money to the merchant. If you don't get the product, simply tell Escrow and they will refund your money back to you.

It should be noted that this activities cannot be used to fraud AliExpress merchant as they have a high technology to trace the product you've bought from them. They will surely know if you get the product or not.

From the above listed point, I believe your mind should be at rest now. You can use them because they are not scam.

NOTE: I am not in any way affiliated with AliExpress or any of it merchants. I only recommend them because they are good, trustworthy and delivers based on my personal experience with them.

Now, I think we can go on...

The process of purchasing your brand new laptop from AliExpress is guite simple. It's no different from any other sites that accept MasterCard or Credit Card as a means of payment. If you have ever bought any products/services on the internet with a Credit Card, then this should be very simple for you. In fact, you won't need to read further if you've already know how to identify the right merchant and quality product. Just go to www.AliExpress.com and make your order straight forward. At the same time, I recommend you still read through these procedures as you will grab some important points to note before ordering any product on AliExpress.

I have summarized the whole procedures into just 4 simple steps for better understanding. The simple steps to follow are:

STEP 1: Get a free account at www.aliexpress.com

STEP 2: Search and locate cheap, quality laptops

STEP 3: Pick the best ones and add them to cart

STEP 4: Order your desired laptop using Naira MasterCard or any Credit Card


That looks simple but there are more to these steps which I will try to explain in simple English so anyone can understand better. So let's get started right away...

STEP 1: Get a Free Account at AliExpress.com

It is absolutely free to register on AliExpress. Visit www.aliexpress.com with your favorite web browser and you should see something similar to this:




Then click **Join Now** and another page where you will have to fill in some data about yourself will show up. The form should look similar to this:




While filling the form, make sure all values are correct. Enter your correct **Email** address and your real **Name**. Then enter your desired **Password** into the two fields. In 'Number 4' above, you can choose either **End Consumer** or **Wholesaler**; the choice is yours. Enter the **Code** shown in the box below it, tick the **Agreement** box and lastly, click the **Create My Account** to submit the form.


If successful, you should see a success message like this:



By this time, AliExpress would have sent a confirmation email to the email address you used in registering. The next thing is to go straight to your email, login and locate the email. Inside this email message, you will find a **Verification Link** which should look like this:



Click the **Verification Link** to verify your email address and you should get a success message telling you that your email have just been verified.




Once that is done, <u>you are through with your registration on AliExpress</u>. Then you should go ahead to fill up your home address. This is very important because that is the address your laptop will be shipped to. The next step is to continue shopping which will lead us to the 2nd step. So click on **Shop on AliExpress now!** to continue with the 2nd step.

STEP 2: Search and Locate Cheap, Quality Laptops


This particular step is very important because this is where we will be looking for not only cheap laptops, but very quality ones. The first thing first is to make use of the search function on the homepage of AliExpress.

In the **Search Box**, which is located above the fold, enter your keyword and then click the **Search** button. This will bring up some search results that best matched what we searched for.



Alternatively, you can make use of the **Categories** in the left sidebar. Point your mouse to **Computers & Networking** and all the **Sub-Categories** will appear to the right. From the list, you can choose the type of product you want to buy.

Using the **Search Box**, we will be searching for 'mini laptops' because these are the set of laptops that goes for N12,000 to N20,000. So enter **mini laptops** into the search box and you should get thousands of search results. When I searched for 'mini laptops', I got over 32,000 search results.




The next thing is to select your **Country**. This is important because not every merchant ship to Nigeria. So selecting Nigeria (Number 1) will bring up all the Laptop Merchant in China that ship their products to Nigeria. In Number 2, you should select **Shipping Method** because not all Couriers are in Nigeria. The most

used and reliable ones are **DHL**, **FedEx**, **EMS**, **UPS** and **TNT**. So make sure you tick them.


Look through the results, see which one best suit your pocket. There are several types of **Mini Laptops** you can choose from. From our search results, the first one is a **7" Mini Laptop** and it goes for \$64.28 (**N10,285**) while the third result (a 13" Mini Laptop) goes for \$125 (**N20,000**). As you can see also, the third one offers free shipping to the Nigeria.

So let's pick up one of the cheapest mini laptops from our search result lists. Going down the result page, I found a 7" Mini Laptop. This is it:



The best part is the Merchant of this laptop (Netbook) ship to Nigeria and the shipping cost is not that too high. It is a 7-inch Netbook. It has a 2GB Hard Disk (HDD) and a 256MB RAM. It is on the Windows CE Operating System.


Assuming you've decided to purchase this laptop, click on it and you will get to the <u>product description page</u> where you will see the detailed info about the product and either add it to your cart or purchase it directly from there.



As you can see in the image above, the price of the laptop itself is \$48.88. Shipping cost is \$21.05. I have chosen TNT because it is the cheapest among other available couriers. The total price is \$69.93. To convert this to Nigerian Naira using N160 as the exchange rate to \$1, the total cost of this laptop is N11,188.

This means, all what it takes to buy this laptop from AliExpress and have it shipped to your doorstep in Nigeria is just **N11,188**.


Most importantly, you should make sure you confirm that the merchant/seller of these laptops is up to the task before buying from them. Looking toward the right hand side of the product you should see something like this:



Looking at the image above, it shows that the merchant has been selling on AliExpress for the past 3 years, they have a positive feedback of about 97% which is good. You can also easily contact them view Chat and Email.

Also, another means you can employ to determine if a seller is reliable and good is to check out the Feedback/Comment section of the product description page. If you go down the product description page, you will find feedback from those that have already bought that same product you are about to buy. For this our sample product, I saw various positive feedback, even from one of our own – a Nigerian – by name Emmanuel. Although I don't know this Emmanuel but seeing his

feedback makes me 100% secure that I won't have any problem with this merchant.



See, on the 16th of April, he order for this laptop. Once he got it delivered to his home address, he went ahead to order for another 2 laptops from the same merchant. This means it's working right for him and you too can be rest assured that if you buy from this merchant, your money is safe.

But before you go on to click the **Buy Now** button, you should also take note of the **Specifications** of these laptops. Once you gather the cheap laptops, don't just go for the cheapest. At times, the cheapest might not be what you really need in a laptop. So view these hand-picked ones you've gathered from your research, click them one after the other to see their descriptions.

On the description page, scroll down the page and you should see all the specs about that product. Using our sample product, these are the descriptions:

Checking the specs will let you make an informed decision on choosing your new laptop. From the above image, you could see that our sample laptop has a 7 inches screen size. It has 2GB Hard Disk with a 256MB RAM. The Battery can last for 3 hours. It comes in 5 different colors and also a year warranty.

If you want something more 'tech' than this, then you should try other set of laptops. Maybe you want a higher RAM and HDD memory size, you can also get them.


Hey, are you asking... what's the Pentium?

Well, I'll leave you to figure it out. But let me give you a clue...

Computer Pentium sizes are determine by the size of their processor. A **Pentium** M laptop has 1.7GHz processor. Since our sample product has 800MHz, I think you should be able to calculate it yourself. For sure it's not Pentium M, or neither is it Pentium 4.


However, this laptop worth its price. You can still perform basic function of a typical computer system on it. But if you have a bigger pocket and wish to go for a better one, then go for it. I'll recommend you buy a better one with bigger memory size if you are a heavy user.

During my searches, I also found a 10" laptop but with a higher price. See it here:



This laptop is a 10" screen-size, 1GB of RAM and 160 Hard Disk Drive. It also comes with 5 different colors and a very neat one indeed.

Let's see the specs here:



It comes with Windows XP operating system and has 1.6GHz Processor. This means this laptop can be said to be a Pentium M laptop.

This laptop which also functions as a typical computer system will function and all what it cost you to have this laptop delivered to your house is N38,826. This is the same type of laptop been sold here in Nigeria as high as N80,000.

This seller is also a verified merchant on AliExpress. Although I can't find much feedback or comments from buyers, it A+ from AliExpress is enough, I think.




With a 97.9% and an Assurance Plus seller, the company can be trusted according to AliExpress. Also make sure the merchant is a Gold Supplier.

So make your research and find not only the cheapest, but the most quality ones you can buy.

Step 3: Pick the best and add to cart

Now as you are browsing through all these laptops, you should be taking note of the ones you intend to buy. After clicking on the item, you will get to the product description page. On this page, you can then click the **Add to Cart** button to save it to your **Shopping Cart** for later use.




You should do this to the entire products you have in mind so as not to forget them in the future. Click the **Add to Cart** to add each item to your **Shopping Cart**, and then click the **Continue Shopping** to continue your search. After you must

have been through searching for the best, you can then go back to your **Shopping Cart** to select the one you really want to buy.




Click on **Cart** to go to view all the products you've send to your **Shopping Cart**. Once on the **Cart** page, you can then decide on which one you really want to go for, then click on it and purchase it.

Here, I have just 2 laptops in my **Shopping Cart**. So I'll just go ahead and click the **Buy Now** button below any of the two that I wanted to purchase.



Or if for example if I want to go for the 2nd laptop, I can also click on it and I will be led to the next page where I will have to purchase it.



Click on the **Buy Now** button to initiate the process of payment. This is where we jump to the next step where I will be showing you how to purchase anything on the internet using your Nigerian ATM Card.

Step 4: Order the laptop using Naira MasterCard or any Credit Card

I think I should say this one more time... before ordering for any product on AliExpress, you should endeavor to chat or send a message to the merchant first. Some of the messages you might want to ask the merchant are:

- Is this laptop still available for sale?
- Can I have 'red' color (if that's your favorite color)

- Can you increase the RAM and HDD memory for me? If yes, to what size and at what price?
- Is a keyboard attached to the laptop? (If no, pls don't buy it)
- E.t.c

If you have more questions, you can ask the seller. You can contact the merchant/seller through Chat and Message. Once you're satisfied with the seller's reply, you can then go ahead to place your order.

The mode of payment is now the problem. But let's look at the payment method used on AliExpress...

- Paypal
- AliPay
- Moneybookers
- Visa
- MasterCard
- Wire Transfer and
- Western Union

With all these payment methods, we just need to focus on **MasterCard**. Although if you have the means to use Paypal or Visa, you can go ahead but these methods are more difficult in Nigeria at the moment. Paypal don't accept Nigeria as a country and to get a Visa Card in Nigeria don't come that cheap. Zenith bank offer Visa Card, which is called **Zenith Web Surfer**. You need about \$120 to get this card. Although, you need \$120 to get this card, only \$20 is used for the card processing and you own the remaining \$100. You can then use the remaining \$100 to purchase your laptop if it's less or equal \$100. It is even better if you can

get this card from Zenith bank because it is accepted worldwide without any hassle. Also, you don't need to have any prior account with Zenith before you can apply for this card.

In addition to Zenith Web Surfer, you can also get a **Dollar Visa Card** from GTBank. This type of card is usually dominated in Dollars and you can only transact on it with Dollar or other foreign currencies.

But if you can't get these cards, then you should go for GTBank Naira MasterCard. I will be explaining this section with GTB Naira MasterCard as a case study. It is easy to get this card from **GTBank**. All you need is to open a **Savings Account** with them and you'll be entitled to this card.

This type of card is called **MasterCard** and you can use it on any ATM machine worldwide so far it has the **MasterCard logo**. It can also be used on any website that accepts MasterCard, so far Nigeria is not banned.

How to Get GTBank Naira MasterCard

The first requirement you need to buy your laptop or any other product/service on the internet is a **MasterCard** or **Visa Card**. So using our case-study, you can easily get a MasterCard from any branch of GTBank in Nigeria.

The steps you need in other to apply for your card are quite easy and simple.

For GTBank Naira MasterCard

- You need to open a Savings account with GTB if you don't have any account with them before. After successful application, you will get your Naira MasterCard within the next 2 weeks.
- Then apply for their Internet Banking either through GTBank website or you go straight to any of their branches nearest to you.
- Next, purchase their **Token**. This Token cost N3,000 and it is used to generate code when transacting online. It is for security purposes anyways and it is a must.
- Login to your GTB Online Banking account and get an Activation Code
- Register your card on MasterCard website.
- That's all.

For GTBank Dollar Visa Card

This one may take much longer time for you to complete, that was the reason I told you earlier to go for Zenith Web Surfer because it is better and faster. But if you want to go for GTBank Dollar Visa Card, this is the process:

- Apply for either a Savings or Current account.
- Then apply for a Domiciliary Account. You need 2 referees which must have a Current Account of at least 6 months old, preferably in GTBank or alternatively in any other banks.
- Once opened, pay \$200 into the Dom account. You might want to use 'black market' to exchange your Naira to Dollar because it's always easier and cheaper with them.
- Go to GTBank and ask them to activate your Card for you.
- Login to your GTB Online Banking account and get Activation Code
- Then go ahead to register and activate your card on MasterCard website.

How to Get Your Activation Code

This is so simple to do. All you have to do is log into your **Internet Banking** account, and generate the code. Please follow the below steps to get your Activation code:


Once you've gotten your Internet Banking activated and gotten your Token, GTB must have sent you your Internet Banking Login Details, which comprises your **Username** and **Password**. Most times, your Username should be a part of your old account number.

First, head over to GTBank website at www.gtbank.com, locate their Internet Banking section by the right, click it and login with your login details.



Before now, you should have your Username and Password handy. It will be given to you after applying for the Internet Banking.

After clicking **Login**, a small window will pop up. After loading, click **Continue** and the login page will appear. So enter your login details to login finally.




The **User ID** represents your Username, so enter your Username here. Then use the on-board number key to enter your password. Then click the **Login** button.



The next page will bring up two options; **View Your Account** and **Get Activation Code**. What we need now is to get our **Activation Code** first. You can choose '**Click here to view your Account(s)**' if you want to check your account balance and also perform any other online transaction.

GTB Internet Banking allows you to generate your Activation Code required to register your MasterCard/Visa Card. The registration will enable you carry out online transaction using your MasterCard or Visa Card on merchant websites that are MasterCard SecureCode or Verified by Visa compliant.

After clicking the **Get Activation Code** link, another page will show up. This is where you will generate your **Activation code**.




Number 1: This is the number carved on the front of your ATM Card. It is predefined already since you're already logged in; the system will auto detect your Card Number.

Number 2: This is the **Expiry Date** on the front of your ATM Card. The first 2 digits is the **Month** while the other 2 digits connote **Year**. So if the Expiry Date on your card is written like this: **03/15**, that means your card will expiry on March 2015. So you should enter **0315** in the box provided.


Number 3: You will also be needing that Token device you bought for N3,000 from GTBank Plc. Just press the white button on the Token device, some numbers will show up on the small screen, then enter these numbers quickly in the box provided.

Number 4: Then click the Submit button.


Once that is successful, you will be presented with your **Activation Code** in blue color. For example, using the image below, our Activation Code is the one that start with 0001. Write or copy this code somewhere safe. Next, click on the link presented just above the code. See the image below to get a clearer explanation:



To complete the registration of your MasterCard/Visa Card, you must click that link and you should be led to the MasterCard website where you will be registering your card and get your **SecureCode**.




Once on the page, click the **Register Now** button to get started. This is a 4-step procedure. You will first be presented with a form to fill in your Card Number, Email Address and others.



Your **Card Number** is the 16-digit number printed on the front of your ATM card. Check this number and type it correctly into the box provided. Do not enter your Bank Account Number here, just your **Card Number**.

In the **Email Address**, enter your email here. The email should be the same with the one you used in opening your account at GTB. Then click **Next** to go to the 2nd step.

This step is very important because this is where you verify your identity. I will use the image below to explain better:



Number 1: Name

You should enter your name exactly as it appears on your ATM card. Do not add or re-arrange your names. For example, if your name is John Micheal Francis and the name on your ATM card is written as Francis John, you must write Francis John in the box provided on MasterCard website.

Number 2: CVV2

CVV2 is a 3-digit security code usually printed at the back of your ATM card. This number is always located immediately after the Signature Panel. So check your card and you should see these 3 numbers, type them inside the box provided for it.

Number 3: Expiry Date

The Expiry Date is on the front of your card. It is usually written in this format: 'Valid Thru 03/15'. The 03 is the month (March) while 15 is the year (2015). So check your own card and locate the Expiry Date and choose the correct month and year on the website.

Number 4: Activation Code

Do you remember the **Activation Code** I asked you to keep safe earlier? The code you generated in blue colors - this is where we need it. Just type the Activation Code into the box here.


And lastly, click **Next**.

After clicking the **Next** button, you will get to the next step which is where you will be creating your **SecureCode**. This is just like a password, so write something you can easily remember but difficult for others to guess and make sure it's alphanumeric. It should be a minimum of 8 characters and a maximum of 10 characters.



Enter your preferred **SecureCode** into the two boxes. Make sure you write this code somewhere safe so that you won't forget because it is important. When you want to purchase the laptop, once you're about to checkout, a CardHolder **Verification** request will appear prompting you to enter your SecureCode. This is the code you will have to enter, so make sure you don't forget or write it somewhere.

Once that is done, scroll down the page to create your Personal Greeting message. Here, you can write anything but make sure it's within 1 to 20 characters long and shouldn't be the same as your SecureCode. Your Personal Greeting can be a phrase or a very short sentence or anything. For example, **She** **Is Happy** is a good Personal Greeting. Please don't use that, it's just for illustration purposes. Make sure you generate yours for a better security measure.



When you're been asked for your SecureCode, your Personal Greeting will be displayed. This means that it is your real bank that you're transacting with so you don't need to fear. All these percussions are important because it is for your own safety.

Then click the **Next** button to complete the whole step. This is the last step and you should get a successful message congratulating you that your registration is successful.



That is it!

Just close the window... you are done. Your GTB MasterCard/Visa Card is now ready to be used on any website that accepts MasterCard or Visa Card without any fear of security issues.

So when you want to make payment online, just make use of your card and your money will be deducted from your account immediately. If you are using the Naira MasterCard and you want to buy from a foreign website, all you have to do


is deposit the equivalent of the amount of the product into your Savings account. When you buys from the website, GTBank will have to exchange your Naira in your account into Dollar using the current currency exchange rate. For example, if I want to buy the 10" Mini Laptop which cost \$242.66, all I have to do is deposit about N39,000 into my Savings account. I will then go to AliExpress, locate my Shopping Cart and purchase the laptop at the rate of N38,825. I have used N160 to \$1 as the exchange rate because that is the current currency exchange rate in Nigeria.

So now that we've got our card ready to be use to buy anything on the internet, let's proceed to how to buy any of these laptops from AliExpress.

How to Purchase Your Laptop Using GTBank Naira MasterCard/Visa Card

Since you have activated and registered your card, it is now ready to be use to purchase anything on the internet where MasterCard is accepted. Fortunately, AliExpress accept MasterCard as one of its payment methods. So in this section, I will be walking you down on how to actually place your order and get it shipped to your home address anywhere you are in Nigeria. So let's begin...

Once you've made an informed decision on which laptop you want to buy among the ones you have in your Cart, login to www.aliexpress.com and locate your Shopping Cart and then click the **Buy Now** button underneath that particular laptop.



After that, you will be presented with a page where you will have to fill in your **Shipping Address** first. This is the address you want the merchant to send your laptop to. If you want the merchant to send the laptop to your own house, then fill in your own house address. Make sure the address is correct. See the image below for a better explanation:

NOTE: The image below is just for an illustration purposes only. Do not use any of the data in it in place of your own information.



Number 1: Email

Enter your primary email address here. This is how you, AliExpress and the Merchant will be communicating to each other. Make sure the email address is correct.

Number 2: Name

This should be your name or the name of the person that will receive the laptop when it arrives. Make sure the name is the same thing with the name on your ID Card because that is what the courier guy will ask to use identify yourself. If you

are not the one to receive the laptop, then enter the name of that person but make sure that is exactly what was written on the person's ID Card.

Number 3: Country/Region

Select your country here. Since you're in Nigeria, just choose Nigeria.

Number 4: Street Address

This part is very important. Make sure you don't get it wrong. Enter your home address correctly and descriptively. The above sample is my own address, do not use it. Enter your own house address in the provided space. Then enter your City and **State**.

Number 5: Zip/Postal Code:

This is also important. It helps the courier to quickly locate your area using the code. If you enter this wrongly, you may never get your laptop delivered successfully. My own **Postal Code** for my area here in Ilorin is 240001. To know your own Postal Code, visit NIPOST website at www.nipost.gov.ng and check for your local government.

Number 6: Tel/Mobile

This is where you will enter your phone number. This is also important because if the courier doesn't meet you at home, they can call you up to come get your laptop. The first box is for your country's code which is 234, while the second box is for the network's area code which can be 080 or 081 or 070. And the last is your mobile number. See the image above and see the format I have used in my example. Just follow suit.


Number 7: Continue

Click the **Continue** button to proceed.

Once you've successfully completed your shipping address and clicked **Continue**, you will be able to proceed with the purchase of the laptop.

You will then be led to the laptop page where you will be placing your order. Once on that page, click on the **Place Order** button and the laptop details will appear. This will contain your shipping address, name and every other information about the laptop including the price. This is just for you to confirm that all info is correct before going ahead to pay with your card. You can then click the **Pay Now** button to proceed with payment.

The following page will be where you will be choosing your mode of payment. If you are using the GTB Naira MasterCard, which is the normal ATM card you will receive after you open a Savings account, you should choose **MasterCard**.



If you have the GTB Dollar Visa Card, it is still the same process of payment. Just choose Visa.

Fill in the information correctly. I think we've cover this earlier. The first one is your Card Number which can be found on the front side of your card. Also, enter the Expiry Date and then the Security Code. The Security Code is the CVV2 at the back of your card. It is usually a 3-digit number just like this:



Then click the Pay My Order button.

You will then be transfer to **MasterCard** website where you will be required to provide your **Activation Code** and **SecureCode**. I hope you still remember all that?


Firstly you need to confirm your Personal Greeting and then enter your **Password**. The Password here is the SecureCode you generated from MasterCard website.

Click on **Submit** and the next page will come up asking you to enter your **Activation Code**. Enter it together with very other details on that page and click the Continue button.

The next page will show up telling you you've successfully paid for the laptop:



Click on the **Pay for these orders now** to complete the whole payment process and you should see something like this:



At this point, you don't have to do any other thing again. If you check your email, you would have received a message from the merchant like this:



They will start shipment within the next 3 days and your laptop will get to your house within 7 days of shipment. Once they've finished processing and shipped your laptop, they will send you another email that your laptop is on the way. Something similar to this:



There are only two things you can do at this junction; 1) wait till your laptop arrives and 2) track the location of your laptop.

When you received that email, it means DHL or any chosen courier has took over your laptop and they are already on their way to your address. Most of the private couriers are reliable so you don't need to worry about your laptop; they will surely get the laptop to the shipping address.

But if you are curious and impatient just like me, you can know the movement of your laptop realtime. Once your laptop is with DHL, they will issue a Tracking Number to you. This is the number you will use to track the location of your laptop. You can do this in two ways; it's either you call DHL and they will ask for your Tracking Number, then they will tell you exactly where your laptop is. Or you can go to their website, find where to enter your Tracking Number, enter it and press Enter and it will show you how your laptop is been moved from China to that present moment you are checking it location.

If all goes well, within 7 days you should get your laptop delivered to your house address. Immediately it's been delivered, you will get another email from AliExpress letting you know that the package has been delivered and that you should confirm if it's the right package and if you are satisfied with it.



If it's different from what you ordered for or discussed with the merchant, you are given the chance to send a **Refund Request** within 5 days of receiving the package so that you can get back your money.

So if you're simply not satisfied with the package, log into www.aliexpress.com, click My Orders and you'll be asked to log in again. You will then see the order you've just placed. Click on **Open Dispute** and follow the instructions to get refund.

On my personal experience, I have not had any course to request any refund because I haven't have any problem with any merchant so far. I always received what I've always purchased.

Wow... congratulations. You are now ready to purchase your own brand new laptop for as low as N14,000.

My Do-It-For-Me Service

I understand not everyone has the time to follow all the above procedures. Although, if you read and follow through what I've just shown you, you should be able to do this yourself. During the course of doing this business, many people has contacted me to help them buy the laptop. Top reason is that they don't have a MasterCard or Visa Card or Paypal, followed by people that are afraid to use their ATM Card on the Internet because of fraud.

However, if by any means you still can't go ahead to get your own laptop, I have an offer to make!

If I'm to buy the laptop for you, this is what is involved:

- I charge N200 per \$1. This means if the laptop cost \$100 (about N16,300), you will pay me N20,000 to get your laptop
- You will need to make a deposit of the laptop amount into my GTBank Account
- You will provide the link to the laptop you want to buy
- You will send me your home address (the address you want the laptop to be sent to)

- I'll look into the Merchant of that laptop, if he is okay, I will then make the purchase on your behalf
- I will then provide you with the details of the purchase, including the Tracking Number so that you can track the location of your laptop till it get to you
