Product Overview

IBM® Lotus® Quickr™ is team collaboration software that helps you share content, collaborate, and work faster with your teams. The product provides software components that enable you to deploy one or two backend services: services for Lotus Domino® and services for WebSphere® Portal. Either set of services provides a first-class team collaboration application. Before installing, read the planning information in the Lotus Quickr information center, available at http://www.ibm.com/developerworks/lotus/documentation/quickr, to determine if one set of services better fits your environment. If you do not have specific preferences, proceed with the installation of services for Lotus Domino.





5 Step 5: Install Lotus Quickr



To install Lotus Quickr services for Lotus Domino, perform these steps:

- 1. Install Lotus Domino.
- 2. Install Lotus Quickr services for Lotus Domino on the same system.
- 3. (Optional) For greater feature availability and easier place member management, configure Lotus Quickr to connect to a user directory.

To install Lotus Quickr services for WebSphere Portal, perform these steps:

- 1. Install Lotus Quickr services for WebSphere Portal.
- 2. (Optional) To store user information and to authenticate users with an LDAP user registry, install an LDAP directory, and configure it to work with Lotus Quickr.
- 3. (Optional) To manage network traffic, particularly in a production environment, install an external Web server and configure it to work with Lotus Quickr.
