

#### 3 weeks on, Newa residents await power transformer

Pulwama, June 30: Inhabitants of Newa town of south Kashmir today slammed the local Power Development Department (PDD) authorities for failing to replace a defunct transformer installed in the locality, for last three weeks.

A group of residents of Astan Mohalla Newa said the authorities are dilly dallying installation of the transformer which had been taken for repairs after it developed some technical snag.

"More than three weeks have lapsed since the power transformer installed in our village developed some technical snag, it was taken by the authorities for repairs but have since failed to replace the transformer and we are forced to live in pitch darkness", said the locals.

The residents threatened to stage a sit-in on Natipora-Pulwama road if the transformer was not replaced at the earliest. "We will be left with no other option as the authorities have turned a deaf ear towards our problems", they said.

They appealed the higher authorities in the department and the government to intervene in the issue. "We regularly pay our electricity bills and despite that the government has failed to ensure supply of power to our area", they said.

Executive Engineer PDD Pulwama said: "The issue was brought into my notice and we will make sure power supply is restored in the area within a couple of days.

Srinagar, June 30: More than 340 candidates on Sunday appeared for the 12th Jammu and Kashmir Yateem Foundation entrance examination held here.

A press handout issued here reads that 344 candidates appeared in the examination including 134 females from 10 districts of Kashmir province.
