Vigilance books former Executive Officer, others

Srinagar, July 2: The Vigilance Organisation has registered a case against Imtiyaz Ahmad Dar, the then Executive Officer Municipal Committee Achabal and other officials for allegedly entering into a criminal conspiracy and in violation of rules making appointment/regularization of 12 CPWs in Municipal Committee Achabal.

According to a statement, it surfaced during verification that Imtiyaz Ahmad Dar, Kousar Ahmad Zargar, then Jr Assistant (Establishment Clerk) and Gulzar Ahmad Magray (Dispatch Clerk) have conferred undue pecuniary advantage upon the beneficiaries and thereby caused corresponding loss of Rs 1,86,004 to the State exchequer by way of drawing salary in favour of 12 non-deserving illegal and fraudulently regularized beneficiaries.

Meanwhile, in another case, the Court of Special Judge Anti-Corruption Kashmir has rejected the bail application of accused Patwari, Nisar Ahmad Ahangar R/o Chimberv Kulgam, who was caught red handed at his residence while accepting bribe of Rs 20,000 and was on police remand from 17.6.2014. The accused has been lodged in Judicial Custody up to 09-07-2014.
