Govt recovers fuel charges from ‘delinquent’ officers

Around 20000 litres of POL illegally issued between 2009 and 2012

Srinagar, June 14: The ghost of alleged double-drawl of fuel and misuse of official vehicles by the Deputy Chief Minister Tara Chand and his persona staff has returned to haunt the National Conference- Congress government.

Following High Court directions in a PIL, the state government has started the process for recovery of fuel charges from the officers of the line departments who have issued the same to the vehicles used by Deputy Chief Minister Tara Chand and his personnel staff between, 2009 to 2012.

In a communiqué (HUD/Lit/ 83/ 2014, dated 10-07-2014), the Housing& Urban Development department has directed departments including Lakes & Waterways Development Authority (LAWDA), Srinagar Development Authority (SDA), Srinagar Municipal Corporation (SMC), Jammu Municipal Corporation (JMC), Jammu Development Authority (JDA) and Urban Local Bodies Kashmir (ULBK) to recover the fuel charges of vehicles attached with Tara Chand and his staff from the officials involved in issuing it.

“I am directed to request you to kindly recover the amount against total quantity of POL,” the letter from Financial Advisor, HUDD reads.

“It is further requested that the actual amount shall be calculated from your records for effecting recovery from delinquent officials immediately.”

According to tentative details worked out by HUDD, the letter states, the cost of fuel (19552 litres) supplied to the vehicles attached with the Dy Chief Minister and his staff works out to around Rs 11. 73 lakh. Of this Jammu Municipal Corporation has issued fuel worth Rs 680700, Srinagar Municipal Corporation Rs 134340, LAWDA Rs 221640, Jammu Development Authority Rs 38940, Srinagar Development Authority Rs 23100, Urban Local Bodies Jammu Rs 30000, Urban Local Bodies Kashmir Rs 36600 and Urban Envi-

ronmental Engineering Department Rs 7800. The fuel was supplied to the vehicles in clear violation of the rules and regulations.

In its status report filed before the High Court, the State Vigilance Organization had submitted that 18 vehicles - nine each of State Motor Garages and security wing of JK Police-remained allotted to Tara Chand and his staff. According to the report, the fuel was supplied by LAWDA, SDA, SMC, JDA, JMC, ULBK, ULBJ and UEED on different occasion between 2009 to 2012.

According to sources the Vigilance Organization is also investigating excess drawl of money by the personal staff of Tara Chand against air travel. “The personal staff of the Dy Chief Minister used to make several copies of a single air ticket utilized by the Minister and get it reimbursed from various field wings of the H&UDD,” Vigilance sources said.

They said in another case an expenditure of around Rs 10 lakh was made by LAWDA during 2009 on organizing a Hawan at the MA Road official residence of the Dy Chief Minister in Srinagar.

When contacted, Secretary Housing & Urban Development Department, Satish Nehru confirmed the development. “We have identified the officials involved in issuing the fuel and the process of recovery is on,” he said.

Too many aspirants delay finalization of mandates

Jammu East, Jammu West, Nagrota, Reasi, Bani, Raipur Domana, Kathua most sought after seats

Jammu, July 14: Grappling with infighting and too many contenders claiming party mandate for one seat, Jammu and Kashmir unit of Bhartiya Janata Party (BJP) is having a tough time resolving differences within the party.

According to party insiders, the biggest problem BJP was facing is that there are too many contenders staking claim for the party mandates from various constituencies making it difficult for the party to finalize the names.

“Too many persons claim representation for a single seat which is ultimately delaying finalization of candidates for upcoming assembly polls,” party sources said.

They said that infighting for tickets

has started in the party as senior leaders are eyeing the constituencies considered as party’s stronghold like Jammu East, Jammu West, Nagrota, Reasi, Bani, Raipur Domana and Kathua.

Sources added that state BJP state president, Jugal Kishore Sharma, who won Lok Sabha polls from Jammu-Poonch seat, wants mandate for his brother Nand Kishore Sharma from Nagrota Assembly segment, which is considered as safe seat as it is being won by BJP since 2002.

Another seat that is in great demand is Jammu West, which has been a party stronghold for a long time and is presently represented by Chaman Lal Gupta - BJP’s rebel leaders.

As per sources former mayor of Jammu and general secretary of party Kavinder Gupta, Yudvir Sethi, in-

charge Jammu-Poonch constituency and Priya Sethi president women’s wing also claim stake for the said seat.

For Jammu East, besides several party leaders, sitting MLA Ashok Khajuria and former women president Sakina Bano are the main contenders.

Another general secretary of party, Bali Bhagat is seeking mandate from Raipur-Domana constituency, which is being represented by Bodh Raj, who was earlier expelled from party for allegedly cross-voting. Bodh Raj was later re-inducted in the party.

There is also a tug-of-war for the Khour Assembly seat between Chaman Lal and Dr Ashok Bhagat who recently joined the party.

The constituency is presently represented by state’s deputy Chief Minister

Tara Chand, who is facing anti-incumbency and charges of corruption.

For high profile Gandhi Nagar Constituency many BJP leaders have already started campaigning on their own.

Former IGP and BJP leader Farooq Khan, Rajeev Charak, Vikaram Randhawa are some names making rounds for the seat, which was lost by party’s Dr Nirmal Singh to Congress heavyweight Raman Bhalla in the last elections.

A senior party leader wishing not to be named said that BJP top brass was caught in catch 22 situation as too many people are staking claim on one seat making their job difficult.

He said that party was expected to release the first list in the first week of July but due to differences within it may take more time.

Mian Altaf for effective third party monitoring of projects

₹ 50 cr earmarked for current fiscal under CAMPA'



Srinagar, July 14: Minister for Forests, Ecology and Environment Mian Altaf has asked the forest department to make third party monitoring system more effective and ensure that inspection reports of the works, conducted by the agencies engaged for the purpose, are submitted in time to the government.

The minister was reviewing status of the projects taken up under CAMPA scheme in the state.

Secretary Forests, Principal Chief Conservator Forests, Director Social Forestry and Conservator Forests (CAMPA) were present on the occasion.

Underling need for focusing attention on

plantation, the minister asked officers to go for massive plantation on open forest land particularly along the roads so that pollution due to vehicular traffic is checked. He asked concerned officers to speed up work on the projects started across the state under CAMPA.

The meeting was informed that Rs 59 crore stands expended during last financial year on various programs taken up under CAMPA scheme in the state while Rs 49.50 crore have been earmarked for current fiscal. Apart from this, the social forestry department has incurred Rs 6 crore under the scheme during last financial year, the meeting was told.

Spurious Drugs: DFCO books manufacturers, dealers

Pentac-20, Sifspas tablets fail quality tests

Srinagar, July 14: The enforcement wing of the Drug & Food Control Organization (DFCO) has booked some manufacturers and dealers who were found involved in manufacture and sale of sub-standard drugs.

According to DFCO, these drugs include Pentac -20 capsules (batch No: PLPT-08125) manufactured by M/s Technica Labs & Pharma Pvt Ltd. Plot No 100 Sec.7, IIE Haridwar UK and Others,

Sifspas tablets (batch no: 6J-197) manufactured by M/s Mkbro Health Care Pvt Ltd 83-Mulanpur Road Ludhiana, and others and Antacid Liquid 170ml (batch no: 133) manufactured by M/s Adorit Pharma Pvt. Ltd. 48, Garoba Maidan, Nagpur.

The Controller Drugs Dr Baldev R Sharma has asked the manufacturers, distributors, retailers, regulators and consumers to extend their cooperation in ensuring availability of standard quality drugs to the masses. He has warned that any person indulging in unethical trade shall be dealt sternly as per the law. **GKN**
