

8 years on, ITI instructors await regularization

Srinagar, Aug 1: The Industrial Training Institute (ITI) contractual instructors have urged the state government to formulate a policy for their regularization on the pattern of Rehbar-e-Taleem teachers. General Secretary, All J&K Academic Arrangements Instructors' Association, Ghulam Mohidin said: "We have been working with Technical Education department for last 8 years without any break. Despite rendering continuous services we are being paid a meager monthly salary of Rs 5500."

He said the "callous" approach of state government towards the instructors had cast them a social stigma.

The instructors said they were appointed strictly on the basis of merit against clear vacancies. "Unlike other teaching staff, we don't have any winter

Govt has no money to pay for pensioners?

Srinagar, Aug 1: State pensioners today complained the government has not released pension payments this month.

The pensioners said they were taken by utter surprise when they found their accounts had not been credited with the pension amount.

A source in Finance department said the state government "has no funds at the moment to release pension payment."

The state government is paying over Rs



200 crore per month to 1.55 lakh state pensioners.

The pensioners said the non-release of the pension had caused lot of problems to them as many among them had to purchase medicine which they could not for want of money.

The source said the government still owed Rs 115 crore to J&K Bank on account of pension payment made by the bank in June 2014.

vacation. We are posted in far-flung areas of Tangdhar, Machil, Loloab, Kargil, Kathua, Surankote, Baderwah, Doda, etc. without any extra allowances. Yet when it comes to regularizing our services, the government plays indifferent," Mohidin said, adding that the government had utilized their services during the assembly, Parliament and Panchayat elections

also. "The government is not even framing a policy for our regularization," they said. They said: "We apprehend that our services will be dispensed with in wake of the joining of the regular instructors after being selected by the SSB."

When contacted, Director, Technical Education, Pervaiz

Khateeb told *Greater Kashmir* that the power to take a decision on their regularization or frame a policy in this regard vests with the state government.

"I can only implement the orders passed by the higher ups in the government. It is not up to me to regularize their services or frame any policy for the ITI instructors," he said.

Govt seeks ways to increase use of broadband capacity

New Delhi, Aug 1: Concerned over under-utilisation of broadband capacity, the government on Friday sought suggestions from the industry to enhance its usage that is at around 50 per cent level. "Whatever infrastructure is available today in broadband, much of it is in government sector. Most of it is not being used. Hardly 50-60 per cent of capacity is being used," Telecom Secretary Rakesh Garg said at i-Bharat event organised by industry body FICCI.

"We have to do lot of work even to make this benefit available to the people," he said, inviting suggestions from industry to enhance the use of the broadband infrastructure.

"What private and government sector can jointly do to

see how we can use most of it, where ever it has reached? At least, it has reached the block level," Mr. Garg said.

He added that the government and other stakeholders have to find the reason for under-utilisation of broadband by the private sector "whether it is cost, speeds of connectivity or is it devices that are very costly".

Mr. Garg said the government is working to connect all the 2.5 lakh panchayats with high speed broadband network but stakeholders need to ensure that the new infrastructure being laid is utilised by people in the rural areas.


"In coming three years all 2.5 lakh gram panchayat will be connected from their block headquarter with broadband which will give them speed of

minimum 100 mbps (megabit per second).


If it reaches to villages and it is not used then its maintenance will be also very costly affair," Mr. Garg said.

Department of Electronics and IT (DEITY) Joint Secretary Rajendra Kumar said the government is ready to provide infrastructure required to enhance utilisation but still for some reason initiatives have not achieved desired impact.

"Out of 252 planned projects, 222 are operational. It is a success. We now need transformation. There is need to integrate services. We must provide core IT infrastructure on demand in plug and play fashion so that they can focus on operation development and not on creating infrastructure," Kumar said. *PTI*

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR COUNSELLING & COUNSELLING SCHEDULE

All the candidates, whose rank is in the range specified in the counselling schedule, must be present personally in the counselling. They have to produce their *Online Admit Card* downloaded by them from the BOPEE website, *all Original Certificates/Documents* as given on pages **24-28** under heading "**13. COUNSELLING FOR ALLOTMENT OF DISCIPLINE/INSTITUTION**" of CET 2014 Information Brochure, including Marks Card of 10+2, a set of *attested copies of these documents*, and a *non-refundable J&K Bank Draft of Rs. 1000 (Rupees one thousand) drawn in favour of FA/CAO, BOPEE/HDFC Bank Challan of Rs. 1000 (Rupees one thousand)*. However, the candidates who have joined the discipline/institution allotted to them in the first round of counselling need not to pay the said counselling fees but shall have to produce **the proof of their admission** (fee receipt of the institution they have joined) and **C.N.A. candidates** are required to produce their Electronic Admit Card. Candidates who have missed their counselling or admission are also eligible for the final round of counselling provided they pay the additional missed counseling/admission fee of Rs. 1000/= in the form of J&K Bank Draft/HDFC Challan.

The **PCM** candidates claiming benefit of **Tuition Waiver Scheme (TFW)** category under category codes 05 & 19 must possess original certificates, with proper office file No. and date, issued by the respective Competent Authorities. The candidates without required original certificates shall not be allowed to participate in the counselling. If a candidate is unable to attend the counselling personally, he/she can be represented by his/her duly authorized representative with **Letter of Authority** from the candidate as per the format given on page 70 of CET-2014 Information Brochure.

The latest **Seat Matrix** will be displayed at BOPEE office, Srinagar and Jammu respectively during the counselling as per the Schedule given above and on BOPEE's websites during the period of counselling. The counselling for allotment of Discipline and Institution shall be **held strictly in accordance to the guidelines given in Information Brochure-2014**. The allotment of seats shall be made to the candidates on the basis of their merit/rank, choice and availability of seat at the time of counselling.

Note:

- Mere mention of a rank in the counseling schedule will not accrue any right to the candidate who is not otherwise eligible. All the reserved category candidates whose ranks are given in the schedule have been enlisted subject to verification of their category certificates. 
