Palestinians accept new 72-hour ceasefire offer

Gaza/Jerusalem, Aug 10: Bloodbath in Gaza continued unabated today with Israeli iets pounding the coastal strip, even as the fragile peace process got a new lease of life with Palestinian negotiators saying they have accepted an Egyptian proposal for a new 72-hour truce with Israel.

"We are here to look for an agreement. We cannot have an agreement without talks, so we accepted an Egyptian proposal to have a ceasefire for 72 hours in order to resume the talks," a Palestinian negotiator said.
