Sub : Engagement of Sikshya Sahayaks during 2013-14.

Sir,

I am directed to invite reference to the above subject and to say that, out of 14,181 Sikshya Sahayak posts, 4,187 posts are to be filled up by the B.Sc. B.Ed. candidates. It is apprehended that, required number of trained science candidates (B.Sc. B.Ed.) may not be available to cater the need.

Considering this aspect, Govt. of India has been requested vide letter No.18305/SME dt.02.08.2013 for relaxation of training qualification and to allow the State Govt. to engage B.Sc. and above science qualified candidates.

In view of this, you are requested to make necessary arrangements in the Web Portal for receiving application of untrained science candidates (B.Sc. and above) with OTET pass of all categories, subject to the condition that, engagement shall only be given to these untrained OTET pass candidates, after permission of Govt. of India on relaxation of qualification is received under Sub Section(2) of Section-23 of the RTE Act.

A revised break-up of Sikshya Sahayak posts is enclosed for needful action.
